**AMARA LEGAL CENTER**

Providing survivors of sex trafficking with legal services, including civil protection orders, family law, criminal record relief, name changes, and victim witness advocacy.



**AYUDA**

Providing culturally-specific legal services for immigrant girls and women who are survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking.



**DC KINCARE ALLIANCE**

Providing legal help to relative caregivers to obtain the rights, benefits, and services needed to ensure a safe and stable home for children whose parents can no longer care for them.



**DC VOLUNTEER LAWYERS PROJECT**

Providing comprehensive trauma-informed legal, advocacy, and support services to low-income survivors of domestic violence and other forms of gender-based violence, focusing on Wards 5, 7 & 8.



**FIRST SHIFT JUSTICE PROJECT**

Empowering workers in low wage jobs to exercise their rights related to caregiving and parenting.



**MOTHER'S OUTREACH NETWORK**

Empowering Black mothers to achieve economic independence, security, and mobility, and equip them with the skills necessary to navigate DC's complex legal, criminal, and foster care systems.
